Quick Start Guide (Save this sheet for future reference or support help.)

What You Need:

- Your VIZIO Router, power adapter and Ethernet cable (included)
- High-speed Internet connection and access to your Internet modem (contact your local provider if you need help with this)
- Additional Ethernet cable (usually provided with your Internet modem)
- A computer to run the Quick Setup App

To set-up your new router, follow these simple steps:

- 1. Unplug the power cable from your high-speed internet modem.
- 2. Connect one end of the Ethernet cable (included) to the number 1 port on the router (Fig. 1).
- 3. Connect the other end to the Ethernet port on your computer (Fig. 2).
- 4. Connect an Ethernet cable from your high-speed Internet modem into the **Internet port** on the router (Fig. 3).
- 5. Plug the power back into your high-speed internet modem. Plug the power adapter (included) into the router and wait 30 seconds before plugging it into a power outlet.
- 6. Wait 30 seconds for the router to fully connect and open an Internet browser window (such as Internet Explorer, Firefox, Safari). Type http://vizio.home or http://192.168.1.1 in the browser window and press Enter (Fig 4). The Quick Start App will automatically start.
